

Journal club procedures

(The Sperm Laboratory, 2007-09-14)

1. Select a paper;
2. Send the paper to Dr. Yang to ask for agreement;
3. Send the selected paper to all lab members;
4. Read the paper and make sure you understand it completely;
5. Prepare your presentation carefully (in *.ppt format);
6. Present the paper and interpret it at the Journal Club on due time;
7. Send the final version of your presentation including the original paper to Dr. Yang.

Special notes:

1. Lab meeting language is English, Chinese language is not acceptable when lab meeting begins;
2. Papers that are selected must be published on top journals, such as Cell, Nature, Science, JCB, JCS, Biology of Reproduction, etc.
3. All papers that are presented must be published recently, those were published in the last three months should be the first choice.
